REMEMBER – REPORT YOUR WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIMS IMMEDIATELY



Reporting a claim as soon as an accident happens is an important factor in controlling Workers' Compensation costs and ensures that your injured worker gets the high quality care necessary for a full recovery and fast return to work.

The medical and indemnity cost of a claim increases an average of 15 percent when the loss is reported more than 3 days from the date of injury.

In addition, these cases do not receive the thorough and caring oversight of a Builders Insurance Group claims representative. Plus there is a direct, long-term impact to your experience mod, resulting in increased Workers' Compensation costs.

- Employers must have a valid Panel of Physicians posted on the job site. It is required by Georgia law.
